Annual Report: Keeping My Promises

In the 2006 election campaign, I made eight promises. Here's an update on how I kept these promises last year.

1) To create a *mobile constituency office* to serve neglected & remote areas of the riding.

In addition to the mobile office hours that we've been holding in some of the smaller communities, I have opened a third constituency office, in Perth. All three of my constituency offices (Perth, Napanee and Carleton Place) are joint offices, providing both provincial and federal services.

2) To consult constituents on key issues, and act according to their instructions.

I have sent out regular mailings across the riding, to determine whether and to what extent there is support for my position on a number of issues.

3) To continue contributing the funds from the MP pay increase for rural emergency health care.

In 2007, these funds were used to place defibrillators in every police cruiser in Smiths Falls and Perth.

4) To transform the Ask if it's Canadian Beef campaign to other commodities and in particular boost 'buying local,' as a way of diversifying the rural economy.

I have conducted three town halls on farm issues, and am setting up a working group to look at how to ensure that domestic & foreign content is clearly labelled on all food products. This will protect consumers, and will help to add value to Canadian-made farm products.

5) To continue doing what I can to ensure that the *property rights* of rural Canadians are protected.

In 2007, I focussed in particular on the issue of mining and mineral exploration on private land where the subsurface rights (or "mineral rights") are owned by the government. I've taken a strong stand in support of reuniting these rights, in the hands of the local property owner.

6) To work for a cleaner voter list, further adjustments to poll locations & ending partisan appointments of Returning Officers.

It has been over a year since I successfully convinced the Cabinet to include, within the Accountability Act, a provision requiring that in future, all Returning Officers be appointed by the Chief Electoral Officer of Canada rather than by the governing party (which was the practice until this year).

7) To publish and publicly distribute an **Annual Report** so that voters can judge whether I am living up to my pledges.

This is my second Annual Report since the 2006 election.

8) To work to reunite Lanark County within the boundaries of a single riding.

I raise this issue whenever possible, in order to keep this issue alive until the next riding "redistribution", which is six years away.


