Annual Financial Report: 2020/21

YOUR MP's OPERATING BUDGET

For the 2020/21 fiscal year (ending March 31, 2021)

In past years, I provided my spending, the average spending for all MPs, and my exact ranking amongst all 338 MPs, in total and in each category. In June 2020, new financial disclosure rules took effect which increased the amount and detail of MP spending that is disclosed to the public, and changed the way MP spending information is categorized. Those new categories are reflected below.

The most substantial change is a consolidation of seven old categories, for which the total spending was given but without any specific details, into one single "Service Contracts" category. The total in that category is provided below, but the details of each service contract, for whatever purpose, are now available online (this was not the case before June 2020).

In addition to the information available online, I can also tell you that I spent \$27,240 **less** than the total office budget allocated to me by the House of Commons, and I did not use any of the \$31,270 made available to me for travel or residence expenses (as noted in the chart below), as is my usual practice.
